- **Treasurer's Report** - QuickBooks no longer is supported, so we are using Quicken instead. Hasn't been much activity this summer. Account is \$2,000 less than what shows on the report (\$8,722.40) because the check for the scholarships was cashed by the High School.

## New Business

- **Teacher's Lunch/Classroom Volunteering:** Will hosting a back-to-school lunch for teachers during their inservice week. A Google Doc was sent out by Rebecca with options to sign up. She also sent a document for helping in the classrooms. There will be something in the main office to guide you to the room where you will assist.
- **Schoolkidz School Supply Program:** Less supplies were ordered than last year.. We had a profit of \$192.33. There were also problems with delivery again this year. Tracey might check into another company or program to see if there are other options available. Mandy inquired about leaving extra supplies at school at the end of the year. Ashley suggested maybe using them for summer school since they were in need of supplies this year.
- **Meet & Greet, August 30th:** Tracey will hand out school supplies at Meet & Greet. We have a trifold board from last year that we will update. The board will include information about emails, or facebook page. Something will go home the first week of school to new families.
- **Open House Ice Cream Social, September 24th, 6pm:** Mandy will be sending a Google Doc out to signup to help with serving ice cream at Open House. Katie W. will check in with Melanie on if we will have any Spirit Wear available. Tracey had received information from Mr. Lehnen on a different company that offers other products and does everything online. She is planning on looking at that again also.
- **Milwaukee Admirals Education Game, November 7th:** We will be going on an all-school field trip to the Admirals Education Game on November 7th. Jessica asked if the PTO would be willing to cover any of the cost for the trip. It was \$250 per bus, and we will need 5 buses to take the whole school. It was decided that parents will pay for the ticket and PTO will cover a portion of the busing cost.
- **Kohl's Wild Theatre:** Jessica received mailing about a program through Kohls. They will come to the school for free to put on a program in collaboration with the Milwaukee County Zoo. Jessica is going to look into booking it on behalf of the PTO, it was said that maybe we could use this in October in place of the usual Halloween events.
- **"Kindness Rocks."** Mandy shared that the Waterford Library program did an activity with rocks that painted black, and then left for the kids to draw or write some type of saying on them about kindness. She tossed around the idea of maybe have a table at open house where the rocks can go out into the community. There was one rock found in Oak Creek that had a message on the back to check out their page and post a picture with the rock before hiding it yourself. She asked us to think about what you think might work, and what might not work when we meet again in September.
- **Activity Assignments:** Tracey went over the activity assignments that were decided at our last meeting. There is a Google Doc for this that she will update as needed. If you are leading an event please add yourself to the agenda if you need to discuss anything at our monthly meeting.
  - When SCRIP was brought up, Jenny mentioned that she has an idea for next year which involves doing a back-to-school order to help people do their back-to-school shopping.
- **Set dates for Activities:** Dates for upcoming activities were decided. Tracey will send out the document with these dates and upcoming events.
