Dear Parents,

Registration for Five-Year-Old Kindergarten for 2018-2019 will be held in conjunction with our regular all-school registration in June. Screening for 5K will not be held since teachers have a good indication of student abilities from the 4K classroom observations.

Registration is scheduled to be held on **Tuesday, June 19th from 7:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. and from 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.** You may bring in any completed forms and pay the associated fees on that day. The registration fee for 5K is \$30.00. Hot lunch is \$3.10 per day and milk is \$.10 (subject to change). Registration will be held in the conference room and parents may enter and exit through the doors by the gym.

We are enclosing some forms that we will need for our records:

1. Health Examination, Vision Examination, and Dental Form. Please have the forms completed by your doctor or dentist and bring them with you to registration.
2. Parent and Medical Information Sheets (new students only), and Immunization form. These can be completed by parents and brought to registration.
3. An Ethnic Background Form and a Home Language Survey is enclosed. These should be filled out for new students only.

Your child's Birth Certificate will be required if you are enrolling him/her as a new student. School personnel will verify the Birth Certificate and return it to you. Your child must be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2018.

We are accepting Open Enrollment students in 4K, 5K, 2nd, 4th, 5th, 6th, and 7th grades.

Information regarding Parent Night/Meet & Greet will be distributed at registration in June.

We have scheduled staff who will be ready to assist you in registering your child(ren) on June 19th. Please make every effort to complete the process on this day. If you cannot attend, we ask that you make alternate arrangements with our office. We would like to have everyone's registration paperwork completed by June 30th so we can begin the process of scheduling classes. We appreciate your cooperation.
