- **Minutes-** There were no questions on the February minutes.
- **Treasurer's Report-** The big things from last month included the money for the art auction and the Father & Daughter Dance.
- **Box Tops-** Profit was \$111.40- Check should be coming soon.
- **Scrip-** Around \$48 between February and March sales.

Old business

- **Valentine's Carnation Sale Overview-** We didn't make any money off of it, but there were a lot of them sold. Tracey found something for next year that would be a lot cheaper. Maybe consider next year that the PTO can get everyone a flower. Mandy was open to suggestions. Everyone thought she did a great job organizing everything.
- **Father/Daughter Dance Overview-** The father daughter dance had the biggest turnout yet. Each year it seems to get bigger and bigger. Jen's Sweet Treats gave all of the profit from the cupcakes to the family of Officer Rittner. The cupcakes were delicious. The music was great, and dads were giving compliments about the event. Having pictures in the conference room worked out good and we can do that again next year. Discussion was had to give the remainder of the dance budget to the family of office Rittner since there was some money remaining. Katie Freimark made a motion to give the remainder of this money to the family. Amanda Dales seconded the motion, and the motion was carried.
- **Grandparents Day T-Shirt Sale:**
 - **1st order= 64 shirts.** It was decided to make the cost of the shirt \$10 each. The invoice came it was an extra charge for larger sizes which we didn't take into consideration. We are okay since we made a bit of money on each shirt that can be used to cover that extra. Total money brought in was \$640, and cost to purchase was \$557 so far. More shirts can be ordered which will adjust this a bit.
 - Tracey was wondering if would we be able to donate the profit of the shirts to the 8th grade class trip as Grandparents Day already has its own budget. They have a large class and are still trying to raise money for their class trip.
 - Dawn Menken made a motion to give the money earned from the t-shirt sale to the 8th grade class. Katie Freimark. seconded this and the motion was carried.
- **Grandparents Day, March 8th-** We have plenty of help and are ready to go!
- **Milk Moola-** We were going to start this at the beginning of the year. Over christmas break we got an email that it was coming to an end. We didn't have enough caps to submit them but Jess was able to pass the ones we did have along to another school for them to use.

- **Sam's Club Membership-** Tracey wants to know who would like to be taken off the Sam's club membership. We have quite a few people on it at the moment. We budgeted \$140 for the membership cost. It was decided to remove everyone except Amy, Tracey and Stacey. This will keep it within the \$140 amount budgeted.

Votes were collected and the amount was voted to be \$500 per scholarship instead of the previous year \$1000 per scholarship.. Thoughts about coming back to North Cape to volunteer were discussed. Tracey also plans to add that they need to have graduated from North Cape to be eligible. Applications will be given out the week of April 22nd, and a meeting to choose winners will need to be before May 10th.
