- **Minutes-** There were no questions on the April minutes. Expect them to be email out after the meeting, and again before the next meeting.
- **Treasurer's Report-** Register report shows that lots of things were paid out this month. Mostly the raffle baskets, and the year books, which we'll get reimbursed once the orders are in. Balance stands at \$5,115.17. About \$287 of that is Sunshine money being held in the account.
- **Scrip-** \$28.40 in profit. Jenny will send one more out for the end of the year, and for summer it can be done online.

Old business

- **Wayne's Daughters Fundraiser:** Close to \$1,000 in profit.
- **BINGO-Jenny Niski:** There were not that many people at BINGO Night. The kids did have a great time. It would be a good thing to do again next year. It might be worth looking into cutting a few events in April and May when sports and other things start to get amped up. The winter events seem to draw in more people.
- **EduKit School Supply Program:** The program is pretty much all set, and it has been updated with the new lists. Kickoff will be May 15th. It will be online only, and will run until the last day of school June 6th. June 7th-July 29th you are still able to order online. It will cost \$20 extra per order, but delivery will be to your house. All other boxes will be sent to school and be ready for meet-and-greet. Last year Tracey sent a mailing to the 4K families so they were able to order also. Prices are comparable to last year prices.
- **Spaghetti Dinner-Raffle Baskets**
 - **Profit:** Profit on baskets was up about \$500. The live auction this year was up about \$1000 from last year. Ticket sales were comparable. Mandy suggested doing something where people could donate smaller amounts of money in a bucket-raffle format. Mrs. Bauer is going to work on this next year which will hopefully allow for more donations from those who don't want to spend hundreds on stuff. Maybe next year we make the baskets smaller and put them into bucket raffles instead. Getting donations is always helpful, so talking about these in January would be beneficial too.
- **Scholarship Meeting:** Dawn has organized all of this and we will choosing the winners after tonight's meeting.

New Business

- **Teacher/Staff Appreciation- Week of May 6-10th:** Paula will send something out on Friday.. The idea of sending money was a lot easier to organize and manage this year.
- **Concert Sell Popcorn and rest of supplies?** Tracey asked about selling popcorn and the leftover candy at the spring concert on Thursday, May 16th. Tracey and Amy will take care of popping and

selling what is left. Also will look at buying the 8th grade leftover soda and sell that at the concert too.

- **New Book Fair Feature:** Scholastic came out with something new this year called eWallet, which allows parents to load money into their students accounts. No more cash, no more change. Students will get to spend the money you allow them to have. Each child will get their own account if parents wish to use it. A flyer will go home with all the kids in the next week. Amy or Tracey will get it up on the PTO website too.
- **Veterans Outreach Food Drive-** May 13th-17th. Pick N' Save will let us go there and fill bags, so we'll need a few people that can help with that. Pamphlets that describe what it will support will go out next week. Christine Csepella, Katie Freimark, Amy, and Rebecca will work on counting the goods 13th and 14th. Incentive for boys vs girls, will be popsicles or some other frozen treat during lunch on Friday, May 17th. Amy will set up jars at a few local establishments, and Paula will get the boxes we need. The book fair will be in the conference room, so counting goods will be in the library this year.
- **By laws change:** Tracey wanted to look at the way we structure the starting of new offices. This would help the new officials start the year once it was finished; not part way through. Tracey made a motion to move the nominations to April from March, election to May instead of April. New offices to start in June of that year. Amy seconded the motion, and the motion was carried. Tracey will update the bylaws and then will send them out.
- **Date Night:** As of now, there are only 9 children who are signed up. Tracey will post something again to see if she can get a few more kids. 8 students are signed up to help.
- **Budget for 2019-2020:** Dawn Menken made a motion to use the same budget from 2018-2019 for the 2019-2020 school year expect for the movie license which will be changed to \$0. Katie Freimark seconded the motion, and the motion carried.
